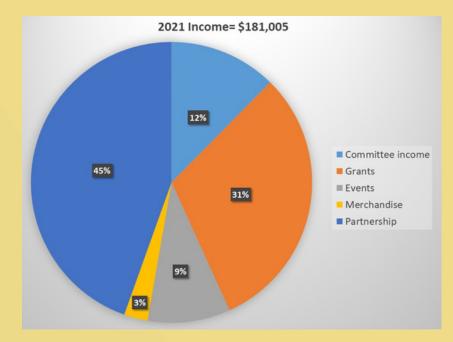

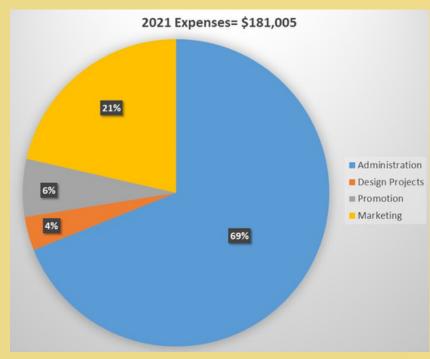

WHAT ELSE DID WE DO IN 2021?

We persevered through the continued COVID-19 challenges, despite reduced staff and the financial impact of less fundraising events for our organization. We still accomplished a great deal for our organization and the downtown district, beyond our 31 events, and we stayed on budget.

MARKETING ACTIVITIES

- Created printed advertisement campaign "Venice: Explore for a Day, a Weekend, a Lifetime."
- Created two new downtown Venice promotional 30 second videos to host on our website.
- Highlighted downtown Venice and 8 Business Partners in two ABC7 Suncoast View television segments airing on March 3, 2021 and November 11, 2021.
- Created and distributed surveys to gather public feedback on our events. Results were
 tabulated to determine marketing effectiveness and opportunities for improvement.
- Published 52 e-newsletters sharing information on hundreds of events and partner announcements. From January to December, subscribers increased from 11,241 to 11,823 (+582); open rate increased from 38% to 52% (14% increase).
- Posted 78 news blogs on VisitVeniceFL.org announing new partners, events, downtown news and other Venice MainStreet activities.
- Posted 1,890 community events on VisitVeniceFL.org 2021 monthly calendar.
- Created content for 12 full pages in the Venice Gondolier and Sun Weekly highlighting the downtown district, events and partners (published bi-monthly).
- Created 44-page printed Venice MainStreet Directory and distributed 15,000 copies.
- Continued funding Venice mural at Sarasota-Bradenton International Airport and coordinated advertising in the baggage claim area for participating partners.
- Managed event promotions on downtown LED gateway arch sign.
- Coordinated Downtown Ambassadors volunteer program with 30+ volunteers and Centennial Park Information Kiosk event postings and printed materials.
- Created content on our social media platforms and purchased Facebook ads for our downtown events.

ECONOMIC VITALITY PROJECTS

- Completed Advancing Mission Thrivability, a strategic consulting opportunity made possible by The Patterson Foundation in partnership with No Margin, No Mission — a national consulting firm and social enterprise. We identified ways to make our organization stronger by focusing our efforts on projects that fulfill our mission while having a sustainable financial rate of return. As a result, we are currently assessing the development of an e-commerce platform.
- Selected for Margin Mission Ignition 2021-2022 program, a second opportunity made possible by The Patterson Foundation. We are identifying earned income opportunities to ensure Venice MainStreet can continue to thrive during difficult economic times.

DOWNTOWN DESIGN ACTIVITIES

- Created downtown Shark Spotting web page, Facebook page and walking loop map in partnership with Gulf Coast Community Foundation. Marketing for the project will be launched in 2022.
- Highlighted additional fairy houses added downtown; updated VenceFairies.com website.
- Held call to artists and judged 2021 Venice Art Festival poster contest. Mary Erickson's "Venice Path" painting was selected.
- Funded additional downtown holiday lighting for \$6,400 (Miami Avenue West and Centennial Park).
- Held downtown holiday window decorating contest and awarded 12 winners.

- Promoted VMS and downtown district through outreach speaking engagements to American Association of University Women, Lion's Club of Venice, Venice Area Women's College Club, Innovative Networking, and many more.
- Met the rigorous standards to maintain our accreditation status in 2021 with Florida Main Street and Main Street America.

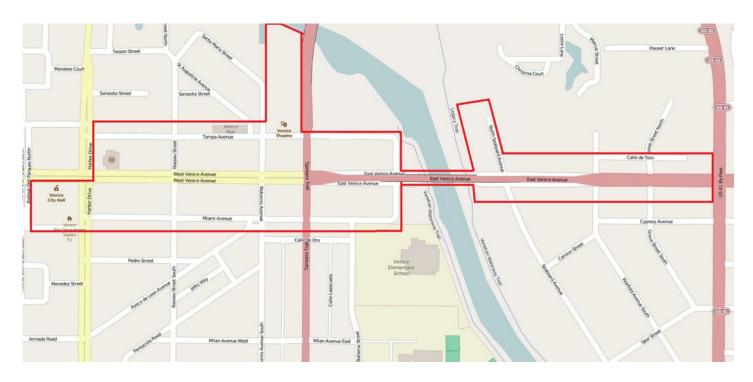
